Participation of Coir Board in the Australian International Sourcing Fair, Melbourne, Australia

Report on the participation of Coir Board in the Australian International Sourcing Fair, Melbourne, Australia

The Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises, New Delhi approved the Board's proposal for participation in the Australian International Sourcing Fair (AISF) by deputing Shri V.S Vijayaraghavan, Chairman, Coir Board and Shri P.K Ravi, Senior Scientific Officer (Poly), Coir Board for three days to organise Board's participation in the AISF held at Melbourne Convention & Exhibition Centre, Melbourne, Australia during 17-19, November 2010. The Australian International Sourcing Fair, 2010 is the first of its kind organized in response to the increasing demand for quality manufacturing and wholesaling opportunities. The AISF was held in conjunction with the China Clothing & Textiles Expo 2010 and AISF provided a forum where international companies can establish and consolidate enduring business partnerships with Australian organizations. The AISF was organized by the Australian Exhibition & Conference Pty Ltd (AEC) covering participants from 160 companies from across the world representing an exciting international collection of home wares combined with the latest in textile innovation, fashion trends, accessories and footwear.

The Melbourne Exhibition & Convention Center (MCEC), the venue is located at 2 Clarendon Street, South bank, Victoria, Melbourne, Australia is a true masterpiece of Melbourne's architectural originality. The MCEC is the first convention center to receive a 6 star Green Center environment rating by the Green Building Council of Australia and is a world class venue offering world class facilities and service with a free space of 30,000 sq mt.

The AISF provided all the information needed on country specific requirements and conducted highly informative, industry lead seminars to learn from a panel of experts and discover the latest tips of the trade. Presentations were made in the seminars by the representatives from Australia, India, Figi, Thailand and Bangladesh during the three days. The national participation in the AISF was organized by the India Trade Promotion Organisation (ITPO). The Indian pavilion in the AISF has a participation of 33 companies besides the following 5 government bodies and associations.

India Trade Promotion Organisation, New Delhi Office of the Development Commissioner (Handicrafts), New Delhi Silk Mark Organisation of India, Bangalore The Cotton Textiles Export Promotion Council, Mumbai (TEXPROCIL) Apparent Export Promotion Council, Haryana

The Office of the Development Commissioner (Handicrafts) arranged the participation of 10 master craftsmen in the AISF.

The Coir Board was provided with a space of 24 sq meters in Booth G14 in the Australian International Sourcing Fair 2010.





The coir and coir products belonging to frame mats(Lovers knot mat, Sinner Mat, Mesh Mat, Corridor Mat), rubber backed and PVC tufted mat, fibre mat-inlaid and stenciled, power loom and hand loom mattings, coir geotextiles (H2M6, H2M5 & H2M9), coir bath mat, coir tray and garden articles from coir(coco pole, fibre tray, fibre basket with and without hanger, fibre pots, fibre disc), coir handicrafts (Coconut tree, Horse, Camel, Deer, Elephant, Tortoise, Giraffe, Nest with and without bird, Coir jewellery boxes containing coir ornaments(coir fibre chain, necklace, bangle, ring and earrings) besides brochures of coir products, Coco lawn, C POM, Coir geotextiles, Coir, service charges and other publicity materials, blow ups of coir composites, coir mat/mattings, coco lawn, coir geotextiles, C POM and coir geotextiles sample kit were elegantly exhibited in the Coir Board stall for creating market promotion of coir and coir products in Australia. Coir Board's stall was the only booth where coir and coir products were exhibited in the Australian International Sourcing Fair, 2010.

Shri V.S Vijayaraghavan, Chairman, Coir Board inaugurated the Coir Board Booth in the Australian International Sourcing Fair, 2010 on 18th November 2010 in the presence of Mr. Donald Conolly, Exhibition Director, Australian International Sourcing Fair, Mr. Hukumchand.T, General Manager, India Trade Promotion Organisation (ITPO), Mr. V. Kumar, Dy General Manager, ITPO, Ms Nisha Patney, Dy Manager, ITPO, Mr. Michael Firman, Sales Manager, Exponets Exhibition and Event Services, Mr. A Ganavel, Vales Eximp and Shri P.K Ravi, Senior Scientific Officer, CCRI.



As the sanction was received only on 16 Nov. 2010 vide letter No: 4(21)2010 - Coir /831, the team from Coir Board was able to reach Melbourne on 17th November 2010 and arranged the exhibits and opened the booth in the Australian International Sourcing Fair only on 18^{th} November 2010.

The entry to the AISF was free to bonafide trade visitors. Around 25000 professionals from various countries in 3 days made a visit to the shows of AISF/China Clothing & Textiles Expo 2010 as they were held concurrently in the Melbourne Convention and Exhibition Center. Special enquiries related to the coir handicrafts, mats, coir pith bricks, coir ornaments and coir bags were received from the trade visitors. Even though numerous people entered and visited the Coir Board Booth, the following showed keen interest in the purchase of coir and coir products.

It was informed to the Consul General of India that India exported 8386.5 MT of coir and coir products valued at Rs.23.28 crores in the year 2009-10 in which coir pith, mats, geotextiles and fibre was the major items exported. The Coir Board Booth was also occupied by the exporters for exhibiting their products.





During the visit to the Conservatory of Melbourne, it was found that the coir basket with hanger was being used for cultivating nursery plants and coir pith for growing plants.
